

RESOLUTION R - _____ - 2025

APPROVING AN EXTENSION OF THE FURLOUGH OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT
EMPLOYEES AND STAFF MEMBERS

WHEREAS, on October 30, 2025, the Board of Aldermen (the “Board”) held a special called meeting that was requested by at least three (3) Aldermen and noticed in accordance with applicable law; and

WHEREAS, at that meeting a resolution was presented to the Board which, if passed as presented, would have temporarily suspended the operations of the Mason Fire Department until such time as the Board determined otherwise; and

WHEREAS, the Board’s intention at said meeting was to amend the resolution to furlough the Fire Department employees for one (1) week beginning on the date of that meeting, without pay, and that amendment was adopted by the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board now desires to extend the furlough period indefinitely, until such time as the Board determines otherwise; and

WHEREAS, the Board is engaged in ongoing conversations with the appropriate authorities to ensure that emergency services will be provided to the Town during the period in which Fire Department employees are furloughed; and

WHEREAS, the Board intends for this new Resolution to be passed in an effort to clarify its intentions with respect to furloughing the Fire Department employees indefinitely until the Board determines otherwise, and ensure it is coordinating with the appropriate authorities to ensure the continued safety of its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Mason, Tennessee, meeting on the 6th day of November, 2025, in Mason, Tipton County, Tennessee, that:

Section 1: The furlough of Fire Department employees adopted on October 30, 2025, is hereby extended indefinitely, effective immediately upon adoption of this Resolution, and shall remain in effect without pay unless and until modified or terminated by subsequent action of the Board.

Passed by a majority vote of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Mason, Tennessee on November 6, 2025.
