

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INCREASE TO SANITATION RATES FOR  
COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 2026

---

WHEREAS, the Town of Mason, Tennessee (the “Town”) provides or makes available sanitation services for commercial customers within the Town;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen (the “Board”) have reviewed the costs associated with providing, maintaining, and administering sanitation services and have determined that an increase in commercial sanitation charges is necessary and appropriate to support continued service; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to increase the sanitation charge for all commercial customers by Seven and No/100 Dollars (\$7.00) per month, beginning June 1, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Mason, Tennessee, meeting in regular session on the 18th day of May, 2026, in Mason, Tipton County, Tennessee, that:

Section 1: The Town of Mason, Tennessee hereby approves a Seven and No/100 Dollars (\$7.00) increase to the sanitation charge for all commercial customers, effective June 1, 2026.

Section 2: The Town Recorder, Town Administrator, and any other authorized representative of the Town are authorized and directed to update the Town's sanitation rate schedule, billing records, customer notices, and other applicable records to display the increase approved by this Resolution beginning June 1, 2026, and to take any other actions necessary to effectuate the same.

Passed by a majority vote of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Mason, Tennessee on May 18, 2026.
